RELEASE ON RECEIPT

NAPLES, FL. -- The Conveyor Equipment Manufacturers Association (CEMA) reported that its August 2021 Booked Orders increased by 89.92% when compared to August 2020 Booked Orders. August 2021 Booked Orders increased by 55.76% compared to July 2021 Booked Orders. July Booked Orders had decrease 13.19% compared to June 2021 Booked Orders.

August 2021 Booked Orders for Bulk Handling Equipment increased 3.60% compared to July 2021 Booked Orders. August 2021 Booked Orders for Unit Handling Equipment increased 67.19% when compared to July 2021 Booked Orders.

CEMA's August 2021 Billed Sales (shipments) increased by 58.31% compared to August 2020 Billed Sales. August 2021 Billed Sales increased 2.46% compared to July 2021 Billed Sales. This contrasts with the July 2021 decrease of 10.63% when compared to June 2021.

August 2021 Billed Sales for Bulk Handling Equipment increased 4.40% when compared to July 2021 Billed Sales. The Bulk Handling increase follows a 3.97% decrease for July 2021 vs. June 2021. August 2021 Billed Sales for Unit Handling Equipment increased 2.06% when compared to July 2021. The Billed Sales for Unit Handling's increase compares to a decrease of 11.90% for last month (July 2021) vs. June 2021.
